

OFFICE OF INDIAN EDUCATION (OIE)

- Established in 2006
- A.R.S. 15-244
- No state funding
- Only 3 staff paid for with federal dollars

State funding is vital for OIE to properly serve AZ's Native American public school students & teachers.

WHO DOES OIE SERVE?



- 22 federally recognized Indian tribes
- Total enrollment: 49,024 students
- Low Density & High Density Schools

HOW ARE AZ NATIVE AMERICAN STUDENTS DOING?

14% chronic absenteeism **&** dropouts

68% students graduating high school

Across the board, Native American students have the lowest proficiency rates for English Language Arts & Math.
